## How to install MySQL Excel Add-in on your computer and add to your Microsoft Excel software


If you want to import Excel data into MySQL to analyze, you'll need to install two things on your computer.

- 1. Visual Studio Tools for Office Runtime
- 2. MySQL for Excel

For you to be able to bring in excel data into MySQL and ensure that it works, the two downloads and installations must be completed. Follow the steps below to install.


First, visit <u>Download Visual Studio 2010 Tools for Office Runtime from Official Microsoft Download</u> Center

When you click the link, it'll take you to the image below. Click the link as pointed from the arrow.






Click this link to first install the visual studio tools for office run time. Once you download, run it and make sure it is installed on your computer Once you are done installing that on your computer, click this link MySQL:: Download MySQL for Excel (Archived Versions) to install the MySQL Excel Add in. When you click the link, it will bring you to the image below.




Once you are done downloading and installing the two, follow the steps below to check if its properly installed on your computer.

Open a fresh Excel document, go to Data and look to your extreme left to see if you have MySQL icon on your Excel Add-in.



And look towards your extreme right corner of the Excel tabs to see if MySQL logo is listed amongst the Add-ins.
